

### Additional learning support for your child – spaces still available!

Dear parents,

Today, a good education is more important than ever. Schools strive to provide all children with the support they need from the very beginning. As a cooperation partner at your child's school, our non-profit organisation **KinderHelden** is helping to strengthen and expand this support network.

Each participating child is assigned a carefully selected volunteer mentor\* for at least one school year.

The child and mentor\* meet for **2-3 hours every week** outside school hours, either on the school premises or at a jointly determined location. Mentors\* **motivate the children** and foster their **reading, maths, and German language skills** in a relaxed and enjoyable way. The programme also includes sports, crafts, excursions and activities, which are fun for both child and mentor alike. In the words of nine-year-old Sara's father:

*"I'm delighted that my daughter is able to experience so many new activities through her mentor Nicole, while also making such great progress in her development."*

**You can enrol your child in this project free of charge.** There are still some **spaces available for children** who would like to have their own mentor\* – **sign your child up now:**

### How can my child join in?

- **Children are enrolled by their teacher with the consent of the parents.**

### What is the procedure?

- Once a child is enrolled, KinderHelden employees get to know the child and look for a suitable mentor\*.
- **Parents are warmly invited to attend the first tandem session** and meet their child's mentor\*.
- Afterwards, meetings take place every week for 2-3 hours.  
**As parents, please ensure that these meetings take place!**

### Who are the mentors\*?

- Upper secondary school pupils, students, professionals and senior citizens
- Committed women and men who pass on their knowledge as friends and role models to the children they mentor
- People who provide tips for learning and who support your child beyond the school environment

\*Girls are assigned a female mentor; boys may be assigned a male or female mentor.
